








Informed where the one and only 1 charger working

The other charger was leaning to one side and all taped up.

If we hadn't't arrived extra early we would have had to Que to use the charger. This is an inadequate facility for a new hotel. At least 10 chargers should be up and running if this is going to be a success.

The room and food were excellent. Seemed less day activities than other hotels, but difficult in winter. No real formal gardens to walk round.

We decided it would be a good place to stop for a night to break up the journey and charge our electric car. On arrival we were very disappointed to find out the charging points only cater for Tesla and not other electric vehicles. This should be made clear on the website when booking as we had to build in an additional 90 minute stop at the motorway services. Other than that it was a reasonable stay. More

#### Nice Hotel but don't expect to be able to charge your electric car for free any longer.


Review of Stirrups Hotel

Reviewed 14 Nov 2023

A very good hotel in a good location and certainly merits more than the 3 stars it has been awarded which I assume is only due to the lack of facilities such as a gym/pool etc. The accommodation itself is at least as good as any other 4-star hotel we have stayed in, as is the food. We have stayed here on numerous occasions and this time we were disappointed to find that the Electric Vehicle Charging which was previously complimentary is now charged at 2 different rates, 1 token is provided for each night's stay at £5 which provides 2 hours of 11 Kw charging. If you need another token, it is £10 which would make this more expensive than some big company fast chargers (when it isn't fast charging) at approaching 50p per Kw. The chargers are labelled as 22 Kw but they only charge at 11 kw. We found this disappointing and this had been a deciding factor in staying a this establishment in the past rather than others in the same area, so I do hope the management will look again at this facility.


